

Year 5 – Remote Learning Explained

For the remote learning all Y5 pupils will need:

- A laptop/ chromebook or tablet (please let me know if you still need to loan one)
- Their class text – Friend or Foe by Michael Morpurgo
- The Green Maths book and whiteboard/whiteboard pen for maths
- The yellow drafting book and pencil for all written activities.

As all activities are online there is no need for any other worksheets etc. These will all be found in TEAMS Files section or ASSIGNMENTS section.

Unfortunately, as I am still going to be teaching Y5 children of Key Workers and Vulnerable groups full time in school there will be no 'live' lessons at present.

All lessons are self-contained with video clips and or powerpoints doing **exactly the same** work as the children in school will be doing.

You can download Teams from playstore/ app store and online for windows/mac. Children's log ins are in their reading/homework diaries.

Email me on Year5@beecroft.leeds.sch.uk if you are having any technical difficulties.

Most importantly children need to do their 3 core lessons each morning MON-WED and their 3 assignments on Thurs/Friday to hand in to me on Teams. This way I can check they are learning and give them feedback.

I have put these 9-12 pm for a routine, but as they aren't 'live' be flexible for what works in your house.

Afternoons will be free choices for the children from the other subjects which as at the end of their plan.
